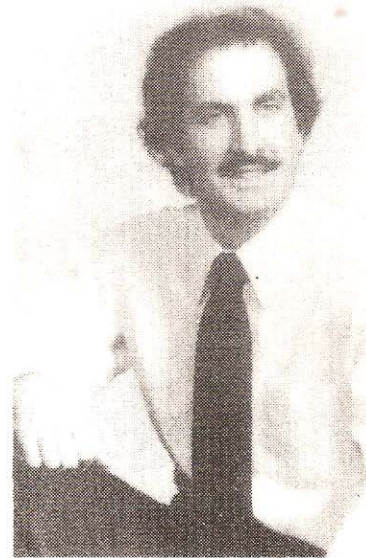
JEFFREY P. DAVIDSON, CMC
